

Rules and Regulations

Violation of any of the below rules is grounds for immediate member termination.

General Regulations

- Park hours are Sunrise to Sunset. All dogs and owners/handlers must leave the property at sunset.
- BARC Park is a membership-only dog park – no exceptions.
- Opening the gate for other persons/pets is prohibited.
- Non-member dogs are strictly prohibited.
- Dog handlers must be at least 18 years old and no children under 12 are allowed in the park at any time.
- There is a maximum of 2 dogs per handler/owner.
- When entering or exiting, ensure all gates (internal and external) are closed and latched.

Pets

- Dogs must be on leash when entering and exiting the park. Leashes shall be removed between the two gates leading to the off-leash area.
- Prong, spike, or choke collars are prohibited. These can cause injury or death during play.
- Retractable leashes likewise are prohibited for the same reason.
- If your dog is digging holes, stop them and fill in the holes immediately.
- Dogs who are aggressive or in heat are barred from the park.
- Please do not use the park if your dog is ill or has parasites.
- Bones, rawhide, and squeaky toys are not allowed.
- No pets under four (4) months old are allowed in the park.
- Excessive barking is not permitted.

Human Behavior

- You must remain in the park and always accompany your pets.
- Pick up after your dog and dispose of the waste properly. Bags and trash receptacles are placed in each park for this purpose.

- Always keep your lease in your hand or on your person.
- No running in the park since this may incite pack/prey behavior.
- Alcohol, smoking, vaping, human food, dog treats, squeaky toys, and glass containers are prohibited. Small training treats are acceptable.
- Professional dog trainers and/or groomers cannot solicit or conduct business at the park.

These rules may be updated or supplemented at any time.
